

## Whetstone Horse Camp

Forest Service officials have reopened the Whetstone Horse Camp in the Andrews Pickens Ranger District. The camp, 13 miles northwest of Walhalla, underwent months of renovation to accommodate larger horse trailers and RV's.

Two of the sites are double sites, meaning they can accommodate twice as many vehicles and horses.

Historical users will notice some changes in rules at the Whetstone site, too. Horses must be tied to the hitching post at each individual site and the number and types of vehicles and where they can be parked will be limited. Also, the number of sites has been reduced by two, from 20 to 18.

Each single site costs \$12 per night; doubles sites are \$24. For more information, call the Andrew Pickens Ranger District at 864-638-9568.
